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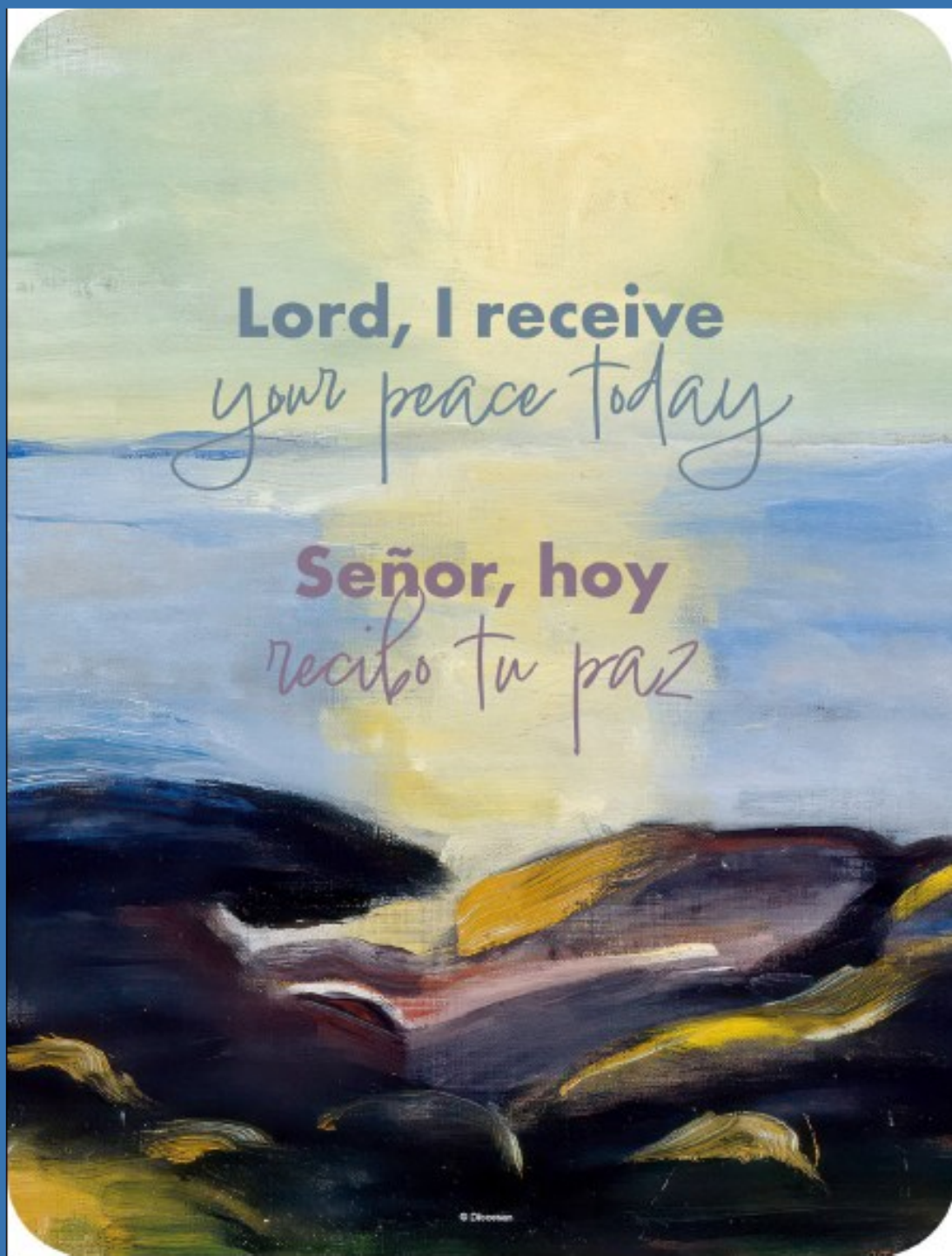

## **Sixth Sunday of Easter A Humble God**

The second reading from Revelations gives us a picture of the new Jerusalem as a sign of the power and majesty of God. Yet the other two readings seem to describe a humble God who wishes “not to place on you any burden beyond . . . necessity” (Acts 15:28), and Jesus in the Gospel tells his disciples that “the Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name . . . will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you” (John 14:26). This gentleness reminds me of an icon by the Russian monk Andrei Rublev that depicts the Trinity as three angels bowing in deference to each other. This humility may be what moved Jesus to say that “the Father is greater than I” (John 14:28). It is certainly a unique way of understanding God.

I used to think of free will as God’s way of testing our worthiness for the kingdom of heaven. But it is more likely part of that same humility, God not being forced on us. While we are given ways to know God, especially through the scriptures and the witness of those who went before us in faith, God leaves us free to believe or not, to love God or not.

So does this mean God leaves us on our own to get through life? No, he gives us the Holy Spirit to teach and remind us of all that Jesus said. That “reminding” is an important way the Spirit helps us today. You may have spent years in religion classes or the RCIA process. When you need an answer to life’s questions, the Spirit may remind you of something you heard from a teacher or read in the scriptures. As you pray over that question, the Spirit may help you understand how the scripture applies to you. So the more you read the Bible, the more likely that the Spirit will have something of which to remind you. *Tom Schmidt*

## **Sexto Domingo de Pascua Un Dios humilde**

La segunda lectura del Apocalipsis nos da una imagen de la nueva Jerusalén como signo del poder y la majestad de Dios. Sin embargo, las otras dos lecturas parecen describir a un Dios humilde que no quiere “imponerles más cargas que las estrictamente necesarias” (Hechos 15,28), y Jesús en el Evangelio dice a sus discípulos que “el Espíritu Santo que mi Padre les enviará en mi nombre, les enseñará todas las cosas y les recordará todo cuanto yo les he dicho” (Juan 14,26). Esta gentileza me hace acordar de un icono del monje ruso Andrei Rublev que representa a la Trinidad como tres ángeles inclinándose en deferencia el uno al otro. Esta humildad puede ser lo que llevó a Jesús a decir que “el Padre es más que yo” (Juan 14,28). Sin duda, es una forma única de entender a Dios.

Antes pensaba en el libre albedrío como la forma que Dios prueba nuestro mérito para el reino de los cielos. Pero es más probable que sea parte de esa misma humildad, que Dios no se nos imponga. Aunque se nos dan maneras de conocer a Dios, especialmente a través de las Escrituras y el testimonio de quienes nos precedieron en la fe, Dios nos deja libres para creer o no, para amar a Dios o no.

¿Significa esto que Dios nos deja solos para que atravesemos la vida? No. Nos da el Espíritu Santo para enseñarnos y recordarnos todo lo que Jesús dijo. Ese “recordatorio” es una forma importante en que el Espíritu nos ayuda hoy. Es posible que hayas pasado años en clases de religión o en el proceso de RICA. Cuando necesites una respuesta a las preguntas de la vida, el Espíritu puede recordarte algo que hayas escuchado de un maestro o leído en las Escrituras. Al orar sobre esa pregunta, el Espíritu puede ayudarte a entender cómo se aplica esa escritura a tu caso. Así que, mientras más leas la Biblia, más probable será que el Espíritu tenga algo que recordarte. *Tom Schmidt*

## **SAINT PHILIP NERI (1515-1595)**

**May 26**

In a shop near the Vatican, a group of Americans laughed as the shopkeeper showed off his fluent English and latest souvenir, a key ring whose papal portrait, when pressed, activated a recorded blessing. Through the shop window, two clerics scowled in disapproval. The shopkeeper grunted, “They’re a very somber order who’ve left the Church. I recognize them.” “By their long robes?” an American asked. “Many in Rome wear robes,” replied the shopkeeper. “It’s their long faces!” When Philip Neri arrived in sixteenth-century Rome, there was reason to be somber. Swiss Guards had been massacred on Saint Peter’s steps defending the pope. Parts of Europe were abandoning the Church. But Philip resolved to be an “Apostle of Joy,” drawing especially the young to Christ—and frequent confession and Communion—by his sincere interest in their problems, prayerful example, and gentle humor. His “Oratory,” a movement as well as a place, provided recreation and devotion in a joyful atmosphere of companionship, service, and liturgy. Philip Neri challenges each of us to begin improving the Church and the world by changing ourselves with unfailing joy. —Peter Scagnelli



## **SAN FELIPE NERI (1515-1595)**

**26 de mayo**

San Felipe tenía dos libros favoritos: el Nuevo Testamento y uno de chistes, sin duda que es el santo del buen humor. Su padre quiso que fuera comerciante, pero una visita a las catacumbas de los mártires transformó su vida. Estando en la Universidad decidió educar a los jóvenes y vender todos sus libros para dar el dinero a los pobres, pues “sólo amar” es lo que cuenta. Se entregó en cuerpo y alma al apostolado juvenil atrayendo jóvenes ricos y pobres al cuidado de los enfermos, servicio en hospitales y vida de oración. Su intimidad con Dios fue tan notable en su sabio consejo que éste fue buscado por obispos y papas; de hecho, fue director espiritual de grandes santos como Ignacio de Loyola y Carlos Borromeo. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1551 y fundó un oratorio designado a la instrucción espiritual, al canto y a la caridad. Debido a su santidad y calidad de vida, uno de los papas quiso nombrarle cardenal y le dejó un sombrero cardenalicio en su cuarto, pero san Felipe lo utilizó para atrapar la pelota. —Miguel Arias

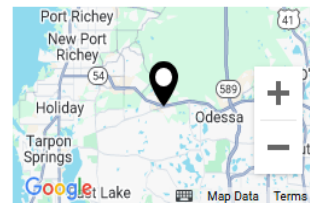
